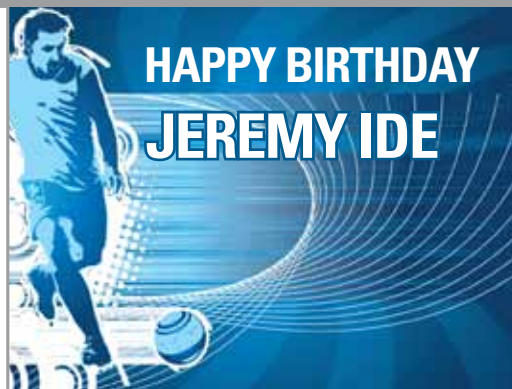

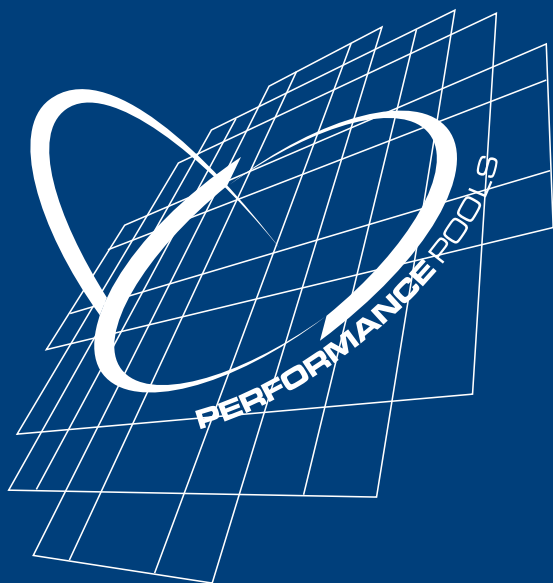


## MONTY MUMBLE
